## **Co-Scholastic Activities**

### **International Level**

- **Space Settlement Design Competition (NASA)** Police DAV Project - Coloumbiat bagged the second position and Bellivistat bagged the third position in the Space Settlement Design Competition organized by NASA.
- **4<sup>th</sup> Asian Space Settlement Design Competition** - The school team participated in the final round of 4<sup>th</sup> Asian Space Settlement Design Competition held at Huston, USA.
- **5<sup>th</sup> Asian Space Settlement Design Competition** - The school project **Columbiad** was declared the Winners in the quarter final round and the project **Ariel** was adjudged the Runners Up in the semi final round.
- **University of Toronto Space Design Contest (Canada)** Police DAV Public School is the first Indian School to achieve recognition and position in University of Toronto Space Design Contest held at University of Toronto, Toronto, Canada. The school project Lakshita won the first prize and Mantavya won the second prize.
- **KHOJ – 2008** – An International Science Festival organized by DAV Centre for Creative Education, at DAV Public School, Gurgaon, the school project **Fire Disaster and its Prevention** won the second prize in the Senior Group out of 37 entries exhibited in this festival.
- **NASA CLOUDSAT Project** – Police DAV is the part of this project alongwith six other schools of Punjab. The work of our school team is highly appreciated by the visiting scientists from NASA from time to time. The scientists have even given the coverage of our school work in **SPAN**, an American Magazine.
- **International Teacher Award** – Mrs. Cinnny Malhotra, a faculty member of Police DAV Public School has been accredited for outstanding development of the International dimension in the curriculum by the British Council. Twenty teachers across India and Sri Lanka were awarded this award and no teacher from Punjab & Haryana had applied for this award.

### **National Level**

- **CBSE Science Exhibition National Level** - The projects, '**Blind Can Read Computer**' and **Robot for Disaster Management** were selected among the top 20 out of 200 projects exhibited from across India.
- **CBSE National Science Exhibition** – The project **CD Waste Management** was selected among the top 20 projects in 2007.
- **IRIS – Open Science Fair** – organized jointly by INTEL, CII and the Ministry of Science and Technology, the school projects **Signature Verification** and **Blind Can Read Computer** were selected among the final 18 projects across India. They further participated in an International Science Exhibition held in Indonesia.
- **National Competition for students' ideas and innovation (IGNITE 2009)** – Two students of Police DAV were selected for their innovative ideas and were awarded a second and a consolation prize respectively by **Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam** on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2009. Out of 1,314 entries across India, only eight students were short listed out of which two students are from Police DAV.

- **Yoga**- Mrs. Rupa Basak, the Yoga Instructor from our school was selected as a coach of the Indian Women Team for **5<sup>th</sup> Annual International Yoga Asana Championship - Vishnu Charan Ghosh Cup 2008** organized by **Los Angeles, California, USA**.
- **Lakulish World Yogasana Championship** -Two students represented Punjab in 2<sup>nd</sup> Lakulish World Yogasana Championship and were instrumental in the victory of the Indian team.

### **CBSE National Sports**

- **CBSE Kho-Kho Championship** winners in both Boys & Girls category for the ninth time.
